

“FUN”RAISER PARTIES

Would you like to help raise money for the school in an easy, fun way? Just host a party. People buy a ticket to come to the party and those ticket sales go straight to the PFC.

Who Can Host a “Fun”raiser Party?

Anyone associated with White Oak Elementary School can host a “Fun”raiser Party. You can host by yourself or team up with a few other parents and co-host together.

What Type of Party Can We Have?

Most anything is possible. It is best to target a specific subsection of our community (e.g. Moms, Dads, Adults, Children only, Grade Level Focused, etc.). Then think of how many people can come to the party. For example, a pool party you might want to cap at 20-25 children for safety while a bounce house themed party at the park could have as many kids as possible. Attached is a list of “Fun”raiser Party ideas, but most anything is possible.

How Does the School Make Money?

The host(s) absorbs the cost of the party and guests buy a ticket (cost of ticket would depend on the type of party). Ticket sales go straight to the PFC to support our various awesome programs. Here’s an example:

Back to School Pool Party for Mrs. Ensey’s 2nd Grade Class
Hosted by The Brockman Family
\$25 per child

If 20 children attend, you’ve just raised \$500 for the school. Cost to you and your co-hosts would be for a lifeguard and snacks and you’re done.

Once that gets done, you should also reach out to those you think would enjoy coming to the party to help personalize the outreach. For example, if you are having a back to school party for your child’s classroom, send a flyer home with all the children, email all the parents and talk about it at drop off and pick up.
