III. General Membership Discussion Items

- a. Principals Report
 - i. Thank you for the fridge
 - ii. Friday 2/9 Events
 - 1. There was a soft lockdown for a coyote sighting on campus and then an earthquake occurred while students and staff were still in the soft lockdown
 - a. Earthquake protocol: once the shaking is over every student and staff evacuates to the blacktop
 - i. Ensures the safety of students by checking gas and power lines before children enter classrooms again
 - b. Every student and staff member was very practiced, quick and efficient
 - c. Thank you for allowing the time to complete our procedures before we had all of the information to update and send a message to parents
 - The guest WiFi not strong enough to work properly in the event of an emergency; lack of access to WiFi and cell service was stressful for parents who were volunteering on campus
 - a. Can we have a dedicated Volunteer/PFC WiFi that is stronger and thus offers better communication for parents in the event of an emergency?
 - i. Thanks to the new walkie-talkie system students and staff were able to move and communicate quickly
 - ii. Principal Smith is going to reach out to the district to see what improvements can be made to WiFi access for parents, volunteers and PFC members on campus
 - iii. Unfortunate Incident
 - 1. Lost Hills was notified of the event with the student being followed after school; they will be handling the incident moving forward
 - iv. Solar
 - 1. The date for install has been adjusted due to typical construction delays; start date will be announced ASAP and in advance

- v. Fence
 - 1. Passed through DSA; start date will be announced ASAP and in advance
 - 2. If construction begins during the school year sides and back of the fence will be done first
- vi. MPR
 - 1. Floors will be done over Spring Break
 - a. New floors are laminate vinyl in a gray color
 - 2. Official approval pending facilities meeting sometime this month
 - 3. Lighting and sound components are still being assessed and reserviced
- vii. State Funding
 - COVID Grant and Prop 28 have been distributed to the districts

 a. Prop 28 allocated amount is less than last year
 - 5 specialists positions for the 9 elementary schools will be distributed for the 24-25 school year; currently we have 9 specialist positions across LVUSD elementary schools
 - a. The number of hours allotted per school will also be less
